There are just twelve positions available, and accepted students will be offered up to a full scholarship to attend Odyssey High School through graduation. Odyssey Scholars are exemplary students who are motivated leaders, students who are inspired by the values of the school, and who are inspired to take action to pave their own path to success.

Through the completion of your application, we hope to gain some insight into you as a student and as a citizen. Odyssey High School strives to create a learning environment that equips students with both academic skills and citizenship, cultivating lifelong learning and strong, creative community members who are skilled in building relationships and creating positive change in our world.

Though there are no set minimum requirements such as a particular grade point average, your application should show that you have the necessary academic background, motivation, and unique character necessary to be successful at Odyssey. Please feel free to include a personal statement if you feel as if your grades do not reflect your full potential.

If you are a rising **freshman**, your application will include two letters of recommendation, existing school records, a standard application, and the student-completed application supplement. To support the determination of financial award, families should also include a copy of the most current tax forms and a letter expounding on your family's need and specific aid request.

If you are a rising **sophomore** or **junior**, your application should include the above mentioned letters of recommendation, as well as an official transcript from your high school as well as any official SAT, ACT or other standardized test scores that you have taken.

One letter of recommendation should be written by a guidance counselor, extracurricular coach, teacher, principal, or headmaster; at least one letter should be written by a teacher in whose class you are currently or were most recently enrolled. Each letter should comment on your strengths, work ethic, and growing edges.

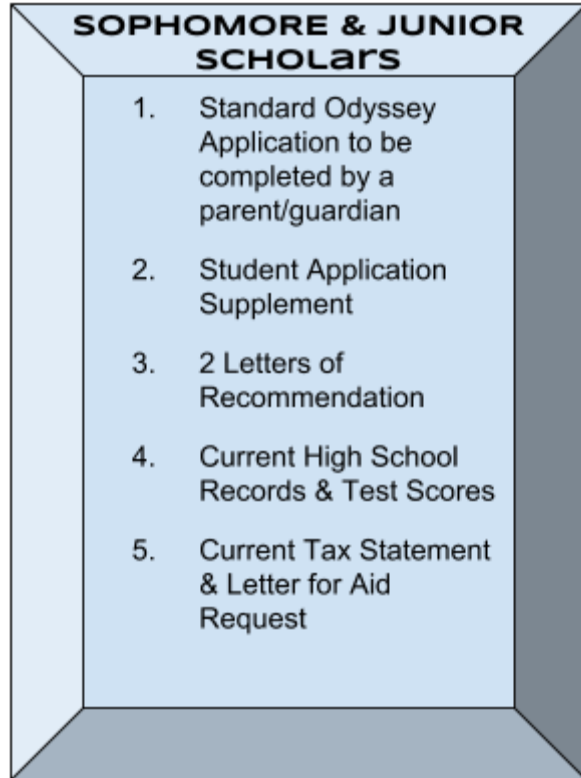
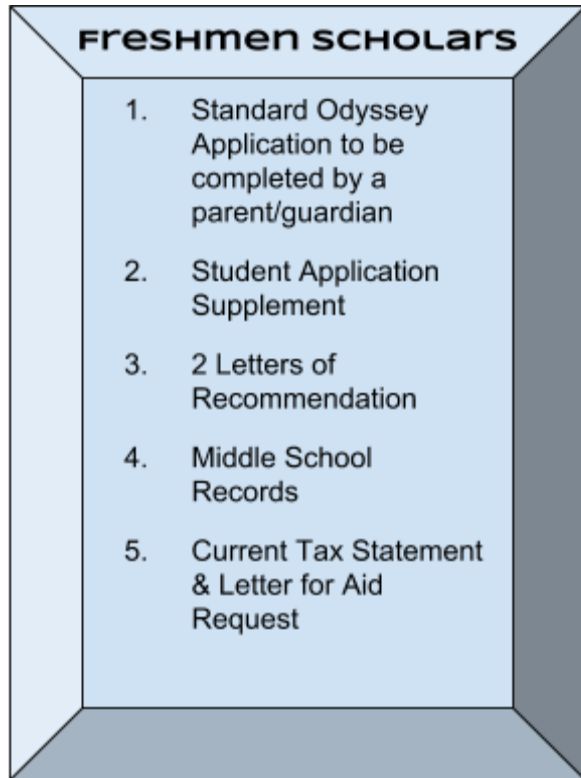
